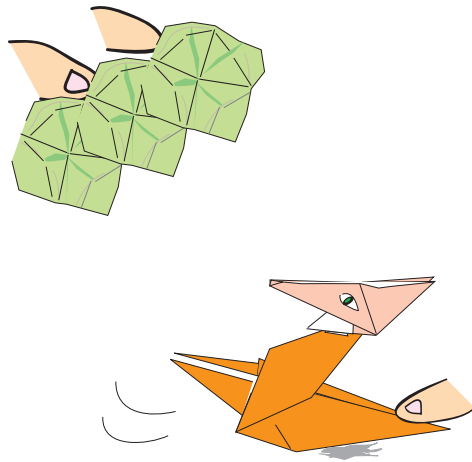


## The Fox &amp; the Grapes ( Aesop's Fable )
