Title The Crab and Her Son (Fable by Aesop)

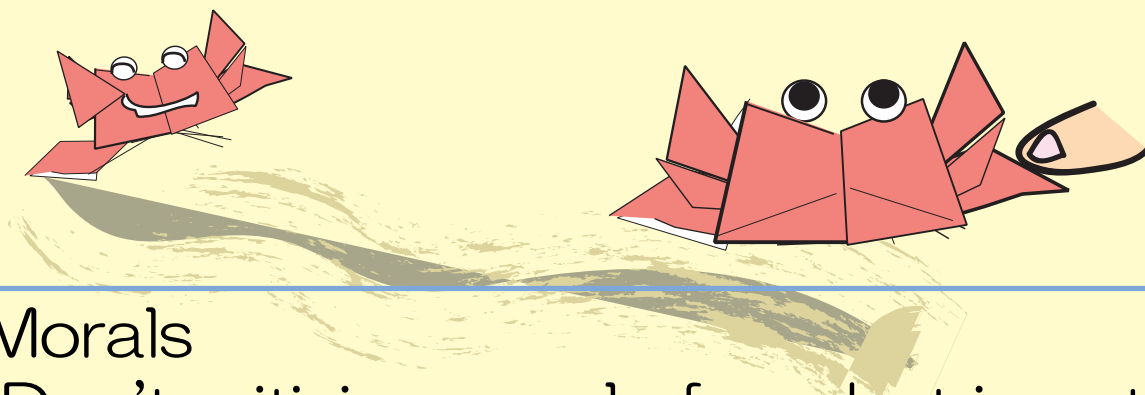
One afternoon a mother crab said to her son, "Why do you walk sideways?"
